RACE ENTRY DEADLINE:

Entry deadline is: Sunday, February 11th, 2018 AT MIDNIGHT PST

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED up until Tuesday, February 13th 12 Noon PST and will be subject to a \$20 per race late entry fee. Also, late registrations will not be seeded. Please contact the Competition Secretary for assistance as the web registration will be unavailable.

Relay team entry deadline is 9:00 am, Saturday, February 17th, 2018.

LICENCES:

All competitors skiing in **Midget to Open** categories of both the mass start and/or interval start races must have at least one of the following licences:

CCC Racing Licence

Other National Ski Licence

• FIS Licence

CCC Supporting Day Member Licence

Competitors in Masters age categories and Bantam/PeeWee/Atoms categories do not need a licence to compete but must be members in good standing of a CCC club.

The relay is not a nationally sanctioned event and no licence is required for any of the categories.

SEEDING:

Seeding will be used for all age categories with the exception of Masters, Bantam, Pee Wee and Atoms categories. If two or more age categories of the same gender are skiing a common distance (for example, Junior Boys and Junior Men) they will be seeded together using the current Canada Points List. These categories will be combined for the start list but uncombined for results and awards.

For the Friday Mass Start race, order of start will be determined directly from the current Canada Points List whereby the highest point's holder starts first within the category.

There will be no seeding for categories that do not require a racing licence (e.g., Masters and Bantam and younger). Order of start will be by random draw.

REFUNDS:

Refunds will only be issued for those competitors who withdraw from the event prior to the race entry deadline of February 11th, 2018 at midnight.

RELAY:

Each relay team is comprised of 3 skiers. There are 9 relay categories:

Pee Wee Boys: Atoms and Pee Wees (Age 9 & under)
Pee Wee Girls: Atoms and Pee Wee (Age 9 & under)
Midget Boys: Bantams and Midgets (Age 10 to 13)
Midget Girls: Bantams and Midgets (Age 10 to 13)
Junior Men: Juveniles and Juniors (Ages 14 to 19)
Junior Women: Juveniles and Juniors (Ages 14 to 19)

Open Men: Open & Masters Men
Open Women: Open & Masters Women
ParaNordic (Sit & Standing, Male and Female)

Relay Rules:

- Younger skiers may ski on older age category relay team, however, the reverse is not permitted.
- A maximum of one female skier may compete on a male relay team.
- An 'Official' relay team will have 3 team members from the same club. Club Championship trophy points will not be awarded to unofficial teams.

Relay registration for pre-registered athletes will be open on Monday, February 12th until 9:00 am Saturday, February 17th.

The link to the no-fee, on-line relay registration will be e-mailed to all registered coaches and it will be available on the event web-site.

BIB PICK-UP: Bibs for each day of racing will be distributed from the Race Office upon opening of race office.

Teck, a diversified resource company based in BC, is the title sponsor of the BC Cup series. Teck provides the awards for ages 15 and under. All Atoms will receive a special Teck participant ribbon. Awards for ages 16 and over will be provided by Telemark. Awards ceremony will occur directly after each day of racing with the exception of Saturday's race.

Teck BC Cup Series aggregate awards will be presented at the evening awards ceremony. Please see the Technical package for more information on the aggregate awards.

The BC Championships is also an annual club competition. Each participating CCBC club accumulates points and the club with the most points is awarded the Club Championship trophy. Points are awarded to the top 5 finishers on Saturday and the top 5 official relay teams on Sunday. See Technical Package for complete details.

AWARDS CEREMONY: The awards for the Teck BC Cup Series aggregate awards will be presented at the evening awards ceremony. Please see the Technical package for more information on the aggregate awards.

The awards ceremony, offering desert and refreshments, is on the Saturday evening at: Westbank Community Hall, 2466 Main St, in downtown West Kelowna.

The \$10 fee for each racer is included in the race registration fees.

Due to the capacity of the community hall, a limited number of additional tickets for family and coaches will be available at the race office for \$10 on Saturday from 10:30 AM to 2PM.

Tickets must be picked up at the race office by end of day Saturday and will be distributed by club/team.

The Telemark Junior Race team will also be selling raffle tickets as a team fundraising activity.

CONCESSION: There will be a concession available.

There is a day lodge at the race site. In addition, one of the machine sheds will be available for shelter. Portable toilets will be located close to the stadium area.

Trail fees will be waived for all competitors, coaches and assistant coaches on each race day and on the official training day, Thursday, February 15th. Passes must be picked-up at the Telemark office and displayed while using the facilities. No pass is required during competition days.

WAX FACILITIES: Outdoor electrical outlets are available on the roadway leading from the parking lot to the

stadium. Waxing is not permitted in the day lodge. Additional power will be made available from the 'old' groomer shed, located nearest to the Telemark chalet, however, it is on a first come, first 'plugged-in' basis. Teams are encouraged to bring portable generators and tents.

WAX TESTING: NO WAX TESTING ALLOWED on the course. No exceptions. A wax testing area will be

designated.

GLIDE WAXCross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in *ALL age categories at all BC Cup races* (and includes the BC Championships). This protocol also applies to coaches, athletes,

wax technicians and parents traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of-country.

The Low Flouro Glide Waxing Protocol is as follows:

Structure tools ARE permitted.

- · Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.
- · Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted.
- · Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.
