#### ELIGIBILITY: All ages are encouraged and welcome to participate in Teck Northern Cup

Athletes trying out for the BC Winter Games must be born in 2006 (U14-2) or 2005 (U16-1) and must be a member in good standing of a Zone 8 club.

Athletes born in 2006 may compete in the 2006 or 2005 age categories. Athletes born in 2005 must compete in the 2005 age category. Once an athlete has chosen which age category they will compete in, they must remain in that category for the duration of the Games.

#### 2020 BC Winter Games - NEW Indigenous Participation Program

Cross Country BC in partnership with the Indigenous Sport, Physical Activity & Recreation Council (I-SPARC) and the BC Games Society will be piloting a new Indigenous participation initiative for the Fort St. John 2020 BC Winter Games.

Up to eight athletes, two coaches and two officials with Indigenous ancestry will be eligible to attend the Games. These spots are in addition to the number of athletes and coaches that are permitted to attend the Games in Cross Country's previous technical package.

This is a strategic initiative by sport sector partners to have more purposeful sport development pathways for participants of Indigenous descent.

- **LICENSES:** Licenses are not required for this event and Zone trial skiers are not required to have a CCC licence for the BC Winter Games.

COLD WEATHER PROVISIONS:	<ul> <li>Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature conditions are unsuitable at start time. Notice will be posted on the event webpage.</li> <li>With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. WAXING:	<ul> <li>Indoor wax space is available, though space is limited. Outdoor electrical outlets are available along the biathlon fence. You will need to bring your own equipment. Be prepared to wax outdoors.</li> <li>CCBC Glide Wax Protocol:</li> <li>Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes in all age categories at all Regional Cup races. This protocol also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians and parents traveling to British Columbia from out-of-province or out-of-country.</li> <li>Low-fluoro glide waxing protocol: <ul> <li>Structure tools ARE permitted.</li> <li>Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.</li> <li>Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.</li> <li>Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT permitted.</li> <li>Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
