Reporting to the Director of Skier Development, the Head Coach is responsible for successful yearly planning and execution of the program.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver athlete programming with individualized training plans, suited to the needs of each athlete.
- Support Skier Development Director on technical issues. Ensure alignment of all levels of the program including Racers, Jackrabbits and Track Attack.
- Provide mentorship to other Black Jack coaches and ensure communication is maintained with other Coaches outside of the club for the benefit of the program (ie organizing camps).
- Support the organization of camps, races and other events.
- Attend races providing leadership, coaching support, wax determination, logistics, direction to parent / coach volunteers, and other tasks as needed.
