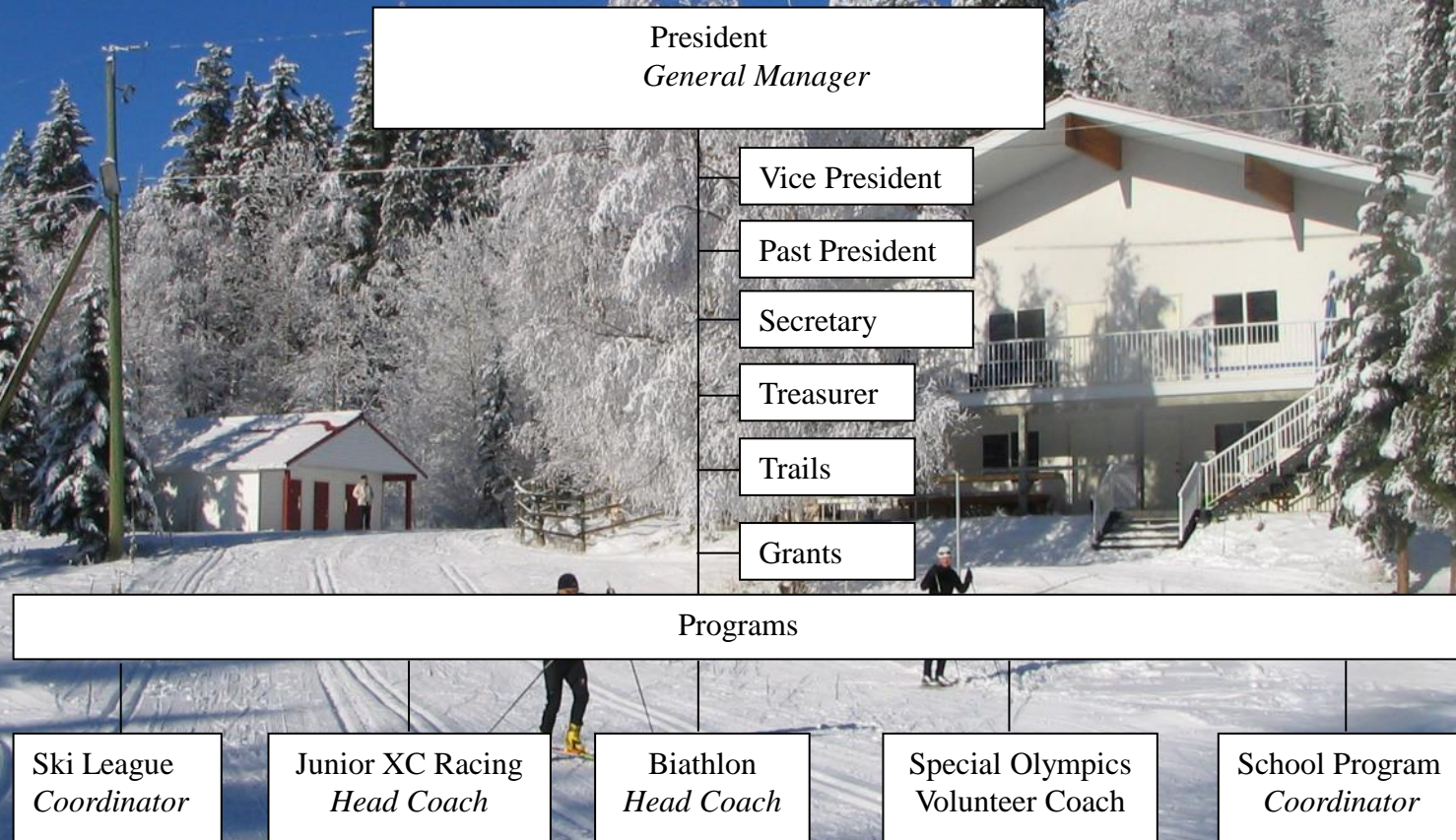

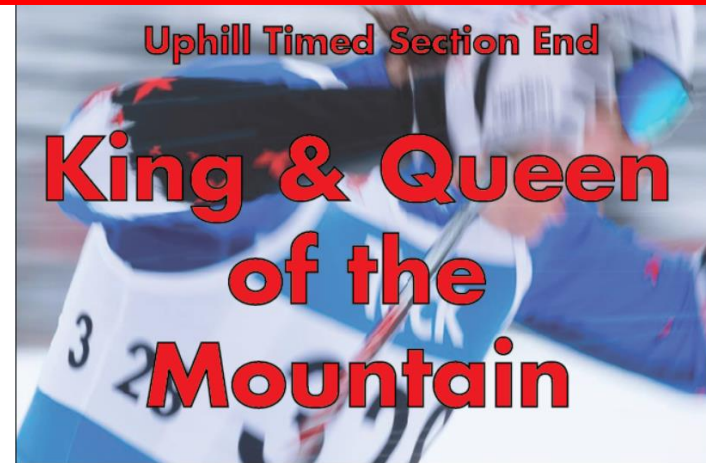

- 600 racers over 2 days
- 1072 timing records without a single miss

- Scrolling live results
- Announcer pre-feed

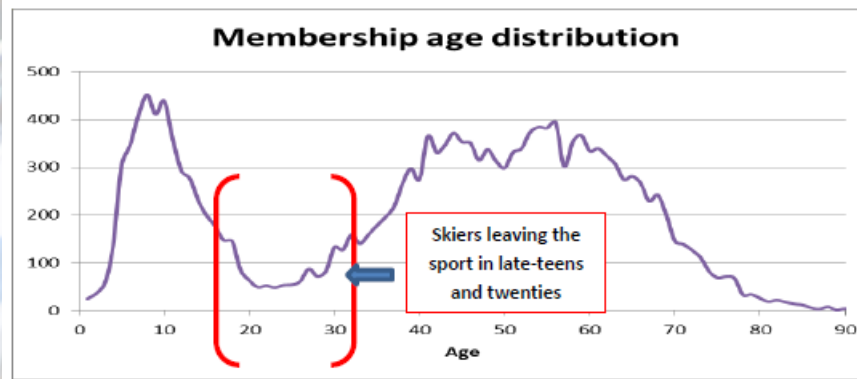
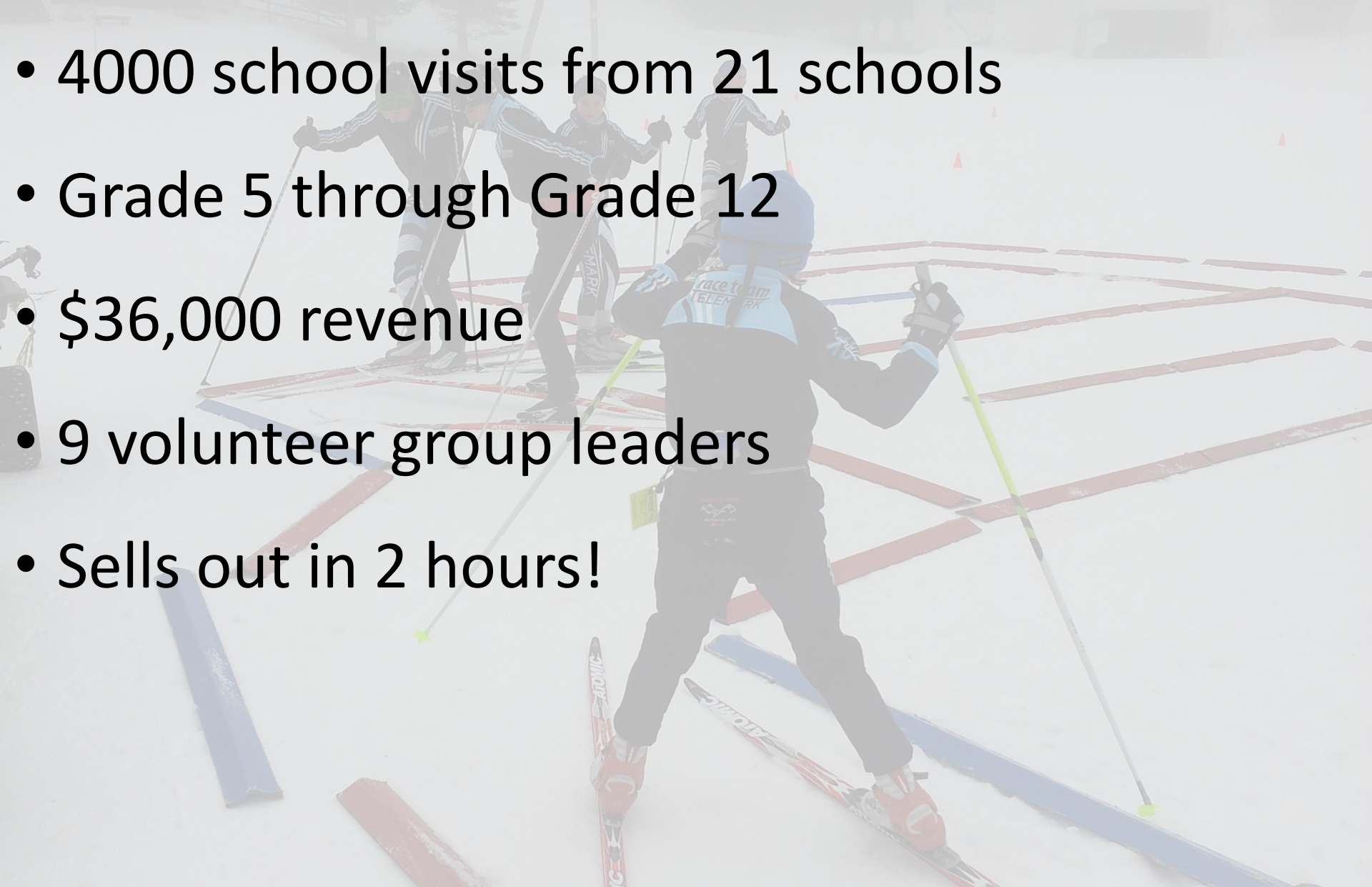
