TECK KOOTENAY CUP #5 & 6 FEBRUARY 14TH – 15TH, 2015

PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS A REVISED RACE NOTICE (POSTED FEBRUARY 12TH). DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS AND SNOW CONDITIONS, THE COURSES AND RACE FORMATS HAVE HAD TO BE CHANGED. START TIMES FOR SATURDAY ARE EARLIER THAN ORIGINALLY POSTED. RACE DISTANCES MAY NEED TO BE CHANGED UP TO THE DAY OF THE RACE. THE CLASSIC RACE ON SUNDAY MAY BE CONVERTED TO A SKATE FORMAT IF WE ARE UNABLE TO SET A TRACK ON SATURDAY EVENING. THE SUNDAY RACE IS AN INDIVIDUAL START AS WELL. PLEASE BE AWARE THAT OUR SNOW CONDITIONS ARE MARGINAL, BUT WE ARE WORKING VERY HARD TO ENSURE THAT THE RACE COURSES ARE EXCELLENT FOR THE DAY OF THE RACE. WALKING ANYWHERE ALONG THE RACE COURSE IS STRONGLY DISCOURAGED AS IT DESTROYS THE LIMITED SNOW THAT WE HAVE. THE PARKING LOT IS PARTIALLY UNUSABLE, AND WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND YOU PARK ON THE STREET IMMEDIATELY BELOW THE LODGE (DEER RUN) AND WALK UP TO THE LODGE.

Please note: Part of the race-course for the 6.5km loop on Sunday may be on a one-way trail (Landsem). This is clearly marked on our trails. Please do not ski backwards on this short section of the race loop during any training sessions prior to, or after the race.

RACE REGISTRATION:

Registration and fee payment is ON-LINE only at www.zone4.ca.

Racers and coaches **must** check the confirmation list on Zone4 (www.zone4.ca) as soon as possible after they complete their registration to ensure that they are registered in the correct categories. RACE ENTRY DEADLINE

The entry deadline for all races is:
Thursday, Feb. 12th 11:00 PM (MST)

RACE FEES:

\$10 (plus HST and zone4 fees) per race for atoms, peewees, and bantams
\$20 (plus HST and zone4 fees) per race for all other age categories
Payment must be made on-line. Credit cards only.
\$5 late fee in addition to above prices for race entries after the 11:00 PM Thursday, Feb. 12th deadline.

LICENSES:

No race license is required. Racers must be paid-up members of a Cross-Country Canada or US Ski Association registered club.

WAIVER FORMS

Waivers must be accepted on line.

START LISTS	Start times (by category) for each race will be posted at the race office and on-line by 9:00 PM on Friday, Feb. 13 th (skate distance race) and on Saturday, Feb. 14 th (classic distance race).
BIB PICKUP:	Saturday: 09:00 – 10:00 AM, outside of lodge Sunday: 7:30 AM – 8:30 AM, outside of lodge The Race Office is located in the Kimberley Nordic Club main lodge
AWARDS:	Awards for the Saturday and Sunday races will be presented approximately 30 min. after the last racer finishes on each day.
FACILITIES	The day lodge is heated and has indoor washrooms. In addition there will be outhouses located close to the parking and stadium areas. Search and Rescue first aid attendants will be present on site.
FOOD & DRINKS:	Post-race drinks and light snacks will be offered to racers and volunteers both Saturday and Sunday in our outside “Feedzone”. The Saturday races will not include a warm lunch. The Sunday race will include a warm lunch served in the clubhouse for the racers, families and volunteers. Donations are welcome and all proceeds will be going to the Junior Racing Program.
WAXING:	A waxing area is available between the day lodge and the small cabin, with many plug-ins available. The area is not under cover. Teams are welcome to set up their own tents for waxing. There is no waxing on the decks of the main day lodge.
